## **Search engines for full-text scholarly articles**

### **Google scholar**

Google Scholar provides a simple way to broadly search for scholarly literature. Allows search across many disciplines and sources: peer-reviewed papers, theses, books, abstracts and full text articles, from academic publishers, professional societies, preprint repositories, universities and other scholarly organizations.



## **Search engines for full scholarly articles**

These are generally based on robots which crawl the Internet and build databases of web sites. Some of them offer selective subject listings for browsing, and assorted other features..

### **Google**

It is advanced, fast search engine with the largest database. Uses link popularity in ranking results - good for finding home pages. Separate search for images and newsgroups, with a directory, a powerful advanced search, and various special searches.

### **HotBot**

Search engine with large database and facility to filter a search in various ways.

### **MetaCrawler**

Returns the best results from leading search engines.

### **Search.com**

Search once for results from over 1000 search engines, directories, news sources, newspapers, discussion groups etc.

### **Mamma.com**

Metasearch tool for web, news, image, video

### **Webcrawler**

This is a metasearch engine that collects data from the internet.
